Full Dentures: A full denture is a removable appliance used when all natural teeth are missing from the mouth.

Partial Dentures: A partial denture is a removable appliance used to replace missing teeth when some natural teeth are still present in the mouth.

#### **CUSTOM REPLACEMENT DENTURES**

This custom denture is made to replace your existing denture for improved fit & appearance!

Full: \$1049/Arch (Upper or Lower) • Partial: \$949/Arch

#### FIRST TIME DENTURE PACKAGE

This package is available to our patients who require extractions & an immediate denture. Most people wear an immediate denture while healing. Following extractions, your gums & bone will shrink while you are healing.

Once your gums have healed, your denture will no longer fit properly. Within 12 months of delivery of your denture, one lab reline is included for a proper fit after surgery at no additional charge.

In addition, any required adjustments to your denture are free of charge for up to 60 days to help you adjust to your new dentures! X-rays, extractions & exam fees are not included.

# **HOW IT WORKS**

# **IMPRESS ME!**

We will begin taking impressions in the morning so that the lab knows how to begin construction of your denture. Other things may occur at this appointment as well. Some things you can expect are discussing your goals, likes/dislikes and expectations of your new smile.

# **WAX & TEETH**

Just before lunch, your teeth will have been set into wax and you will try them on so we can customize the fit and new look of your denture.

### **DELIVERY**

Later in the afternoon, your new smile will arrive. Your dentures are not your natural teeth, just replacements and should be viewed as such. While they may look very similar they will not function in the same manner that your natural teeth did. Just like breaking in a new pair of shoes, new dentures will require an adjustment period. When you arrive in the afternoon, the Dentist may need to make minor adjustments in order for your denture to fit properly. The next several days of wearing your new set of dentures may cause sore spots and reveal uncomfortable areas. This is normal and will require another adjustment at the dental office. Simply call us for an appointment.

# **HOME CARE**

Your dentures will give you many years of service if you give them appropriate home care. We will review home care with you and encourage your compliance to maximize the life of your dentures. Below are some pointers to get you started:

- 1. Sleeping in your dentures is highly discouraged; your gums need to rest!
- 2. Brush your dentures with a tootbrush, at least twice daily to keep them clean from food debris and bacteria that thrives in the mouth.
- **3.** Do not use toothpaste on your dentures; It is too abrasive for the material which results in tiny scratches which can harbor bacteria, causing stain and odor.
- **4.** Soak your dentures in water at night; they are more comfortable if they have not "dried out" prior to placing them in the mouth.
- **5.** Never wrap your dentures in a napkin or paper towel; This is the best way to have your pretty smile thrown away. We provide cases for the safe keeping of your beautiful smile.
- **6.** Never use household cleaning products to clean your dentures as this is a health risk.
- 7. If your dentures require additional cleaning, you may want to use soaking tablets that are made just for this purpose.
